Political Background

2nd EaP Youth Forum 2015 invited EC to **dedicate a programme to young people** in Eastern Partnership countries.

Confirmed at the **Riga Summit in 2015**: **economic growth and employability**, particularly for youth, top priorities for action.



New EaP youth programme (indicative)

- 3 year programme to be launched in early 2017
- About 20 Million EUR
- 3 components

1. EU4Y Capacity building

- a. Civil Society Fellowships
- **b.** Partnerships for Entrepreneurship

2. EU4Y Grant scheme

- a. Grant scheme for policy development with a focus on youth entrepreneurship
- 3. EU4Y Coordination



Objectives

- Increase the **employability** and **participation of young people** in society and economy.
- Support them in becoming **leaders** and **entrepreneurs** and developing **skills**.
- Enable youth organisations to engage in cross-sectorial youth policies and cooperate with public and private bodies and institutions.
- Bring together relevant authorities with other key stakeholders, like businesses, social partners.
- Attention to disadvantaged youth and women.



Component 1: EU4Y Capacity building

- Empower young people with **key competences** and skills supporting their active participation in democratic, social and economic life.
- Civil Society Fellowships for youth:
- Capacity building projects supporting youth organisations to become active participants in policy-development and policy making.
- Selected young leaders (the Fellows) will take part in mobility activities and working in the EU.



Component 1: EU4Y Capacity building

Partnerships for Entrepreneurship:

- Capacity building projects promoting entrepreneurship education and social entrepreneurship among young people.
- These transnational projects will be based on multilateral partnerships between organisations
- Involvement of the **private sector** and **educational institutions** will be important.



Component 2: EU4Y Grant scheme

- To increase the educational and training opportunities and improve the employment perspectives for youth.
- <u>Capacity building projects</u> addressing **educational and training opportunities for youth** with special attention to **vulnerable and disadvantaged young people**.
- Support creative young people in maturing their entrepreneurial ideas.



Component 2: EU4Y Grant scheme

- Support leaders in the education field who offer quality education to all young people.
- Focus on economic sectors with higher appeal on youth i.e. innovation & IT, creative industries, green economy, and social entrepreneurship.
- Involvement of private sector is key.

Mainly Voluntary Service, youth exchanges, and some training and networking

Call for Proposals (about: 16 000 EUR/project)

465 projects funded (EaP organization in the lead)


Mainly training and networking, youth exchanges, some EVS (but only from Programme countries to EaP countries)
